

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

Candidates must have completed their Undergraduate or Postgraduate degree in a relevant discipline from a recognized University. They must score a minimum of 50-55% aggregate marks to be eligible for Bihar B.Ed. Admission. The required minimum score for applicants from the reserved category is 45%. Most B.Ed. admission in the state of Bihar are offered through combined Entrance Test every year from 2018. Total Course duration for one successful Academic year is 2 years.

OVERVIEW

Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) at Mother's International Teacher's Training Academy is a 2 years course at the UG/PG level. The course offers admission to 100 students.
